- Excels in the area of mentorship, seeking to actively guide and support their peers.
- Inspires those around them through their commitment to faith and involvement in leadership opportunities.

# CRITERIA

The Scholar Athlete Award recognizes two graduates (male and female) who:

- Maintains an academic average over 80%, while actively participating in two or more athletic programs.
- Demonstrates integrity and good sportsmanship.
- Models discipline, teamwork, and perseverance.

External sports participation will be taken into account in cases where BCS is unable to provide the program.

<u>The graduate is responsible</u> for submitting a completed application form, verified by an adult reference, by the final deadline of April 30 in their graduating year.

<u>The committee is responsible</u> for choosing a recipient who not only meets the above criteria but also demonstrates the values of Bearspaw Christian School in their daily life. The Award Committee includes members from the Leadership Team, Grade 12 teaching staff, non-teaching staff, Discipleship Team, and any other relevant individuals associated with this award.
