BCS Grades 5 - 12 STUDENT UNIFORM POLICY

All students are expected to be in proper uniform, as outlined in this policy, while in attendance at BCS.

Students in Grades 5 to 12 May Wear the Following Uniform Pieces

BCS Embroidered Top (all tops from [Top Marks](#), our uniform supplier, see information below)

- Navy or iris blue t-shirt (long or short sleeve)
- Navy or iris blue polo shirt (long or short sleeve)
- Navy quarter zip sweatshirt
- Navy crewneck sweatshirt
- Navy full zip mockneck jacket
- Navy warm-up jacket
- Navy cardigan sweater (discontinued but grandfathered)

BCS Sanctioned Bottom

- Top Marks plaid, pleated, knee-length kilt or skort (for girls)
- Navy or khaki color pants, capris, or knee-length walking shorts
 - Pants must be loose-fitting
 - No sweatpants, tracksuit pants, corduroy pants, or jeans
 - Pants are not required to be purchased from Top Marks

Gym Strip for PE and Courses Involving Physical Activity

- BCS Phys. Ed. t-shirts in house colours (one t-shirt provided by school)
- Modest shorts (mid-thigh or longer), sweatpants, tracksuit pants, or athletic pants
- Indoor runners (non-marking soles)

Other Uniform Considerations

- Only tops with the BCS logo are acceptable uniform dress
- Only BCS Top Marks jackets may be worn in class
- A BCS uniform top must be worn under a cardigan (no tank tops)
- Additional clothing worn under a BCS uniform (ie: t-shirts, leggings) must be navy blue, gray, black, or white. No pants can be worn under the kilt or skort
- Hoodies are not allowed (except Grad Hoodies for Gr. 12's only)
- Kilt and shorts length must be to the knee
- BCS Phys. Ed. t-shirts, Bears paw Barbell, and BCS/Grizzly Gear clothing are NOT part of the school uniform and may not be worn in class
- No outside clothing is to come to class (jackets/hoodies/blankets) or worn between classes
- Pants must be worn at the hips (no low riders)
- Hats may not be worn at any time during the school day (in your locker)
- Students should be in uniform on class field trips, unless otherwise directed by the teacher
- **Please ensure all articles of clothing are in good condition, clean, and clearly labelled**

Casual Days

On “Casual Days” students may dress in regular clothing. All students are expected to dress appropriately, both for an academic and Christian atmosphere. “Modesty” is the key word when deciding what is appropriate.

Inappropriate casual day clothing includes:

- clothing that advertises anything contrary to a Christian lifestyle
- short shorts, skirts, dresses (shorts and skirts should be mid-thigh or longer)
- crop tops
- tight or torn clothing
- cleavage or undergarments showing
- sleeveless tops must have straps at least 1” wide
- hats may not be worn at any time during the school day

All uniform pieces are available through Top Marks. Fitting days are held each spring at the school. If you are unable to attend the fitting days, uniforms can be ordered as follows:
